The annual golf tournament hosted by the Lakeshore General Hospital Foundation at the Royal Montreal Golf Club on June 3 raised more than \$80,000.

The money will go towards the purchase of a gamma camera, which scans the body's organs to detect the presence of diseases, including cancer.

After a patient is injected with a radioactive pharmaceutical, the

camera can detect abnormalities in the brain, thyroid, lungs, liver, gallbladder and kidneys.
