A dedicated training AED is a cost-effective, safe, and essential investment for preparing healthcare teams to respond effectively to cardiac emergencies.

4 key reasons to have a training model AED:

Realistic and Safe Training Environment

- A training AED allows healthcare professionals and students to practice using the device in a safe, controlled setting without the risk of delivering an actual shock.
- It mimics real-life cardiac arrest scenarios, helping staff become confident and efficient in emergency response.

Improved Code Blue Response

- Hands-on practice with a training AED enhances team coordination, decision-making, and response times during Code Blue situations.
- Regular simulation with the correct equipment leads to better outcomes during real emergencies.

Preservation of Functional AEDs

- Using actual clinical AEDs for training drains battery life and wears out equipment meant for patient care.
- A training model ensures that clinical devices remain fully operational and ready for real emergencies.

Skill Retention & Confidence Building

 Repeated exposure to training AEDs reinforces muscle memory and builds confidence, especially for nurses, orderlies, and new staff who may need to act quickly under pressure.
