Program Vision

To honor the generosity of individuals, families, corporations, and foundations whose philanthropic support helps transform patient care and enhance the hospital's infrastructure and services.

Purpose of the Program

The Naming Opportunity Recognition Program exists to:

- Inspire transformational gifts.
- Publicly and permanently honour major donors
- Align donor support with specific areas of impact within the hospital (capital improvements, equipment, patient experience).
- Encourages legacy giving and community investment in healthcare.

Types of Recognition

- Permanent Naming Signage: Prominently placed in or near the named space.
- Donor Wall: A physical display showing names by level.
- Commemorative Plaques: Personalized and installed.
- Hospital Publications: Recognition in newsletters, annual reports, website
- VIP Tours: Hosted with hospital leadership and medical staff.
- Legacy Society Membership: For planned/estate gifts, with distinct visibility.

Naming Opportunity Categories

- 1. Capital Naming For spaces (new or renovated).
- 2. Programmatic Naming For services, outreach initiatives, or departments.
- 3. Endowment Naming Gifts that support programs in perpetuity.
- 4. Memorial or Tribute Naming To honor a loved one or a legacy.
- 5. Matching Opportunities For corporate sponsors or challenge grant donors.

Operational Guidelines

- Approval Process: All naming rights are subject to approval by the Foundation
- Duration: Naming is typically granted for 10–25 years (or perpetuity if endowed).
- Donor Agreements: Formal documentation ensures donor intent and outlines duration, renewal, and stewardship commitments.
- Recognition Plan: Each donor receives a customized stewardship journey, including progress reports, milestone updates, and ongoing engagement.

- Elevates philanthropic culture.
- Encourages multi-year and major gifts.
- Creates visibility for community leadership.
- Enhances funding for capital improvements, like your in-patient psychiatry unit renovation
