### Totals

### Training Programs Offered:

1. **Continuing Education for Physicians and Staff**
  - ACLS & BLS training delivered by an external instructor
2. **Continuing Education for Lakeshore Clinical and Non-Clinical Staff**, delivered by Lakeshore Nursing Care Advisors:
  - Code Blue
  - CPR Training
  - ER Drop-In Days
  - FORCE (various topics, including transfusion)
  - ER Simulations – weekly
  - Weekly Nursing Skills Days
  - Empowering CSIs
  - Unit-Specific Simulations – Chain of Survival – monthly
3. **Education for Medical Students and Residents**, provided by supervising physicians
4. **Interdisciplinary Training for the Entire Emergency Department Team – Code Blue** (physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, patient care attendants, and others)
5. **ER SIM Boot Camp for Medical Students**, led by Dr. Fay Knight
  - Offered on the first day of each Emergency Department rotation
  - Seven sessions per academic year (one for each of the first seven periods)
6. **Training on Simulation Mannequins and New AMBU Equipment**
