Updating the unit is essential to ensure timely access to life-saving procedures, including early detection and treatment of colorectal cancer and other serious conditions.

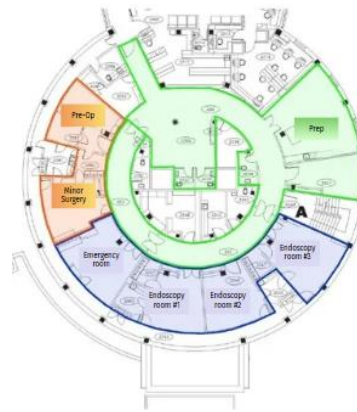
Why the need?
